Subj: LETTER OF TECHNICAL DIRECTION (#09-002USMC R1) PERSONS ELIGIBLE
FOR TRAINING

Ref: (a) FLEET INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY CENTER (FISC) SAN DIEGO CONTRACT

1. Reference (a) provides that the Contractor deliver training services in accordance with the Statement of Objectives.
2. The ultimate purpose of the training services supported by reference (a) is the reduction of the mishap rates of military personnel and civilian employees. With regard to training associated with motorcycles, such training is generally required to be provided to military members and civilian employees as a matter of service order or instruction. These instructions have been interpreted differently across the service in how they are to be applied to dependents, retirees, contractors or visitors to USMC Installations.
3. In an examination of the current instructions, proposed changes under consideration, and guidance issued by the Navy on this subject, military dependents and retirees with a need to access USMC Installations may receive motorcycle safety training provided under reference (a) on a space available basis. However, training priority is to be given to military members and DoD civilians. This will promote efficiency and maximize utilization of training resources. *With the exception of OCONUS personnel for whom training is mandated by DoD under a Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA), visitors to or contractors/non-governmental employees working on board a USMC Installation are not eligible to receive training provided under reference (a).*
4. The government considers the direction contained in this letter to be within the scope of reference (a). If you disagree, please contact me within three (3) business days.
