Subj: LETTER OF TECHNICAL DIRECTION (#09-003USMC) USE OF GOVERNMENT OWNED MOTORCYCLES

Ref: (a) FLEET INDUSTRIAL SUPPLY CENTER (FISC) SAN DIEGO CONTRACT N00244-08-C-0032

1. Reference (a) provides that the Contractor deliver training services in accordance with the Statement of Objectives. For motorcycle training in the Basic Rider's Course (BRC), motorcycles are to be provided by the Contractor in numbers as assigned to various USMC installations.
2. Additionally, several USMC Installation traffic safety programs own motorcycles for use in BRC training. Insofar as the purpose of these motorcycles is to facilitate the training of service members and DoD employees, use of such government owned motorcycles in training conducted by the Contractor is permissible in cases where motorcycles provided under the contract are either (1) fully utilized or (2) not available.
3. In instances where the installation allows use of government owned motorcycles for the contractor's use, the installation shall provide appropriate oversight and technical support prior to and during their use. The use of government provided motorcycles shall not result in any additional costs to the government under this Contract.
4. The government considers the direction contained in this letter to be within the scope of reference (a). If you disagree, please contact me within three (3) business days.
